Roald Amundsen, born in 1872 near Oslo, Norway, left his mark on the Heroic Era as one of the most successful polar explorers ever born. He became the first to travel the Northwest Passage, in his ship *Gjoa* in 1903-06. He led the Antarctic expedition of 1910–12 which was the first to reach the South Pole, on 14 December 1911. These are but two of this intrepid explorer’s many explorations and adventures. As a distant second cousin of Roald Amundsen, Jason has researched, written and spoken on the topic of his famous relative numerous times and is excited to make this presentation to the Scandinavian Business Club, as are we to have him.
